



# Philadelphia Junior Tour

## Operation Changes for Player, Staff and Spectator Safety

The following changes will be made to all Philly Junior Tour events once play resumes:

- There will be no registration table at PJT events. Players will check in on their starting hole.
- Clubhouse access may be limited or restricted during events.
- Practice facilities may not be available at PJT events. Range and putting green availability are subject to the host course. We will try and communicate that information prior to the event or when tee times are emailed out.
- Hand Sanitizer Stations will be available at all events near the 1<sup>st</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> tees
- Tee Time intervals may be spaced out longer to aid in social distancing on the golf course. The PJT will follow the host courses suggested tee time interval length. Because of this, tee times may not always be the same from event to event or field sizes may be reduced slightly.
- Starters boxes, pencils and scorecards will not be available on the starting holes. Please prepare yourself with any items necessary before starting your round.
- Scorecards will not be exchanged among players. Each scorecard will have all players in the group listed and score will be recorded for each player by everyone. Scores will be compared when your turn the card in.
- Once the round is completed and your card has been turned in, please leave the property to avoid any gatherings. Temporarily, we will not be awarding any medals after the divisions complete.
- Players can receive their membership packet for 2020 at the scoring area of their first event. It will be available via contactless pickup.
- Updates to events, policies and procedures will continue to be communicated by email.
